<b>Title of the project</b>	Improvement of Livelihood of the most Vulnerable Families for Prevention of Human Trafficking and Unsafe Migration
<b>Goal of project</b>	<p><i>Overall objective:</i></p> <p><i>The project goal is to improve the livelihood of vulnerable people through dissemination of agricultural technical innovation such as system of rice intensification (SRI), ecological chicken raising, home gardening, awareness raising on agricultural pesticide and its impact, formation of producer group for collective selling, etc.</i></p> <p><i>Specific objectives:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Increasing household food production and income generation capacity through ecological agriculture innovation and producer group</li> <li>- Supporting the establishment of self-sustained and member managed village based farmer association/cooperatives and networks</li> <li>- Support capacity building to PDA and PDWA staff through involving them in the process of planning monitoring and evaluation of the project</li> </ul>
<b>Project Duration</b>	June 2008 to December 2009
<b>Target Area</b>	14 villages across 3 communes of 3 districts, Sithor Kandal in Prey Veng province, Kampong Ror and Chantrea districts of Svay Rieng province
<b>Target Group</b>	The most vulnerable families of human trafficking and unsafe migration, included the poorest families, the women-headed families, migrant workers,

<b>Main Activities, Expected Output, and Indicators</b>	<p>Activities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Organizing village general meeting</li> <li>- Organizing workshop with stakeholders at the commune level</li> <li>- Exposure visit for the interested farmers</li> <li>- Group training of experimented farmers</li> <li>- Group training of key farmers</li> <li>- Group training of the 5 palm producer group representatives</li> <li>- Group training of 5 palm producer group members</li> <li>- Thematic workshop</li> <li>- Organize group training of saving group representatives</li> <li>- Organize group training of VFA representatives</li> <li>- Farmers exchange extra village</li> <li>- Quarterly supporting mission to the project</li> <li>- Follow-up and advice</li> </ul> <p>Expected outputs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Totally, 800 families in 14 project's target villages or 25% of the total families in each target village will receive the beneficiary from the project, the beneficiaries of the project are considered to those who have participated in the capacity building training,</li> </ul>

	<p>exchange visit, individual follow up advice, and learning materials distributed by the project.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- At least 5 demonstration farms will be developed by farmers per village</li> <li>- Reduce the usage of chemical fertilizer 20% and the understanding on chemical pesticide</li> <li>- 14 collective saving groups will be facilitated to set up, so there will be one saving group in each target village.</li> <li>- 5 sugar palm produce groups consist of 50 farmer producers will be set up for collective selling of the sugar palm</li> <li>- 42 key farmers<sup>1</sup> will be the main village's resource persons in term of agricultural technical innovation (System of rice intensification, home gardening, ecological chicken raising, etc)</li> <li>- The 140 target beneficiaries will increase the agricultural productivity by 50% over than their habitual practice. Importantly, all the total 800 target families will understand well about the negative impact of agri-chemicals (fertilizer and pesticide) on the human health and environment.</li> </ul>
