



1. Title of project	Integrated Commercial Farm for Small Farmers in Takeo's Samrong district (ICM)
2. Goal of project	The overall goal of the project is to develop the integrated commercial farming as an effective use of their available resources in a sustainable manner of agricultural production compatible with climate change adaptation and habitats of biodiversity. To achieve this goal, there will be two main objectives as follows : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To increase food production using integrated techniques in small farming, - To develop farmers' and CBO/NGO partners' capacity to create ideas related to the development concept proposals.
3. Project term	From July 01, 2009 to December 30, 2010, with funding support from GEF SGP, CEDAC will implement the project.
4. Target area and group	The project will work closely with 30 small farmers and 30 people from 15 CBOs/NGOs partners based in the Samrong district of Takeo province.

6. Main activities	(Activities): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Organizing and conducting a baseline survey of Key farmers and CBO/NGO partners -Organizing the training of key farmers and CBO/NGO partners - Organizing the training and exchange visits of key farmers - Organizing the training and exchange visits of CBO/NGO partners -Organizing exchange visits and field visits for key farmers and CBO/NGO partners - Supporting and supervising field- based practices
7. Expected outputs and Indicators	Anticipated results are shown as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At least 20 farms will be constructed - 15 chicken producer groups will be set up with the members of 150 families and 10 organic rice producer groups will be set up with the members of 100 families. They are all involved in the marketing with CEDAC Natural Agri-Product (NAP). - 30 people from 15 CBOs/NGOs partners are involved in these activities. They also have an opportunity to learn about ways to establish the integrated commercial farm and farmer producer groups and marketing. Especially, they gain experiences in regard to the process and approach of the project and to mobilize ideas related to the development concept proposals.
