Target Areas:	The project will be implemented in 60 village located in 6 communes across the Kahn Chriech district of Prey Veng Province
Beneficiaries:	The project will benefit a total of 2,500 small farmer families from the target villages.
Project Goal:	To contribute to the eradication of extreme poverty and hunger among small-scale farmer families, enhancing their resilience against climate change, drought and soil degradation.
