Project Goal:	The overall objective of this project is to prepare communities to better absorb development assistance with effective engagement of individuals and households in a learning community structure.
Project Objectives:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide communities with relevant prior information to enable them to identify their learning and information needs generally. 2. Build capacities and promote dialogue in preparation for investment projects as well as provide ongoing feedback and information mechanisms to assist with project and program information. 3. Provide more broadly grassroots level input into the policy analysis work of the MAFF and into wider scale policy development with respect to rural poverty reduction, service delivery options, indigenous, ethnic minority communities and approaches to gender analysis and mainstreaming.

Milestone and it time frame:	<p>The NGO will maintain and provide monthly progress report made during the implementation of learning community in the 2 target communes. A detail field report at the end of each series community visit should be attached. These series of community visits and its milestones (with approximate timeframe) will include but are not limited to the following activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Discuss on the drafted work plan2. Site visit and ToT training on LC materials and tools3. Facilitate learning activities in the target communes/villages4. Identity/assess existing relevant networks, strengthen and link LC with local expert and service providers5. Assist CCs in application of new knowledge/skills in CDP/CIP process6. Update and link services providers with target communities7. Facilitate the sharing of best practices among stakeholders8. Assist LCDP team in collecting and providing feedback on RULIP activities and relevant policies9. Conduct regular monitoring and provide feedback on LC materials. Prepare monthly report including financial report.10. Prepare final report to be submitted to L&L.
