

Workshop on Understanding the Cambodia National Strategic Plan for Food Security Development in Cambodia

27 May, 2010

With funding support from Rice Watch and Action Network, CEDAC organized a workshop on Understanding the Cambodia National Strategic Plan for Food Security Development in Cambodia at the Cambodian Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC), Phnom Penh. 20 people (2 women) including representatives from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF); the Council of Ministers; SRI Secretariat; NGOs; private rice mill companies; Community Rice Mill Cooperative; Rice Watch and Action Network; and CEDAC, attended this workshop. The objectives of the workshop were to:

- Understand and take part in the National Strategic Plan for Food Security Development in Cambodia
- Prepare for farmer adaptation of the Plan in respective communities

During the workshop, many interesting topics on food security were presented and discussed with a question and answer session. Those included the National Strategic Plan for Food Security Development in Cambodia; Food Security and Nutrition in Cambodia; National Responses After the Rice Crisis; and CEDAC's participation in food security development.

By the end of the workshop, the participants understood much more about the National Strategic Plan for Food Security Development in Cambodia, especially how it will influence rice production in the next rice farming season.
