

CEDAC Organizes District Workshop to Introduce the Project Concept

KAMPONG CHAM: On 19 July 2011, a CEDAC's project called "***Promoting climate resilient livelihoods for Small-Scale Farmers in Most Vulnerable Dry Land Areas in Siem Reap and Kampong Cham Provinces/PCR Kampong Cham***" organized a district workshop to introduce the project concept to 57 participants including 10 women in Kampong Cham Province . This meeting gathered the districts' vice-governor, district councillors, commune councillors (from 6 target communes), farmer representatives, youth representatives, school teachers/school principals and representatives from the concerned district offices and was facilitated by Mr. Hour Sreng, project coordinator of PCR in Kampong Cham Province.

To begin the workshop, Mr. Vann Seun and Mr. Seung Khunny District Councillor of Pon Ngeakrek District provided an opening speech in which they mentioned that CEDAC is implementing a development project which shall contribute to poverty alleviation in the district.

During the workshop, Mr. Hour Sreng presented the project concept to the participants. In Kampong Cham, the project is implementing in 172 villages across 13 communes in 2 districts of the province.

At the end of the event, participants seem to have gained more understanding of the project as well as about climate change concept. More importantly, local authorities are ready to cooperate with the project in order to address the climate hazards in their respective communities.
