

CEDAC Hosts an Exposure Visit by Director of Winrock International Cambodia

From August 11 -12, 2011, CEDAC organized an exposure visit to Pursat province for the project, “Children’s Empowerment through Education Services” (CHES). In total, four people including Mrs. Anna Deonela, Director of Winrock International and Mr. Sem Samnang, a CEDAC staff member were in attendance. The purpose of the visit was to assess the agricultural innovation practices by community based facilitator (CBF), target families (TF) and young agri-entrepreneurs (YAE) who have been trained by CEDAC. The Exposure Visit attendees interviewed stakeholders to find the progress and impact.

As a result, Mrs. Anna Deonela highly appreciated the efforts and achievements that have been made by CBFs, TFs, and YAEs. She noticed that many farmers have applied agricultural innovations introduced by CEDAC. However, she did suggest that young agri-entrepreneurs should work to improve the existing system that records their business activities and transactions .

With funding support from United States Department of Labour (USDOL) and through Winrock International, CEDAC is implementing a project called “Children's Empowerment through Education Services” (CHES). The project contributes to improving the livelihood strategy for targeted children, (ages 15 to 17 years old), and parents of withdrawn children of the CHES project.
