

Intensive training for project staff and outstanding farmer promoters

PREY VENG PROVINCE: From October 21 - 27, 2011, CEDAC's project titled "Improving food security of the most vulnerable families in Prey Veng," which was funded by the European Union (EU), cooperated with the provincial department of rural development, and organized an incentive training for the project staff members and strong farmer promoters on sanitation and clean water. Three districts received training including Kampong Trobek , Preah Sdach and Baphnom districts, with 73 participants consisting of 54 strong farmer promoters (29 of whom were women) and 19 project staff (3 of whom were women).

The purpose of the training was to strengthen the capacity of project staff members and strong farmer promoters to promote the concept of sanitation and clean water amongst farmers during and after flood waters. The training especially focused on the impact from unsanitary water usage and how to produce clean water for daily consumption.

During the training, the facilitators provided visual aids, such as posters, to explain to participants one by one the meaning of the picture that was shown. The facilitators introduced the present progress of sanitation worldwide. The facilitators spent one day providing concept theory and one day doing the practices together in the field.

After training, project staff members and farmer promoters gained a lot of new concepts to enable them to promote this concept among farmers in their community during and after floods in order to improve community health.
